Martin Luther King Jr. (1929-1968) was a minister and social activist who played a key role in the American civil rights movement from the mid-1950s until his assassination in 1968. Dr. King sought equality for African Americans, the economically disadvantaged and victims of injustice through *peaceful* protest. He was the driving force behind events such as the Montgomery Bus Boycott and the March on Washington, which helped bring about landmark legislation. Dr. King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 and is remembered each year on Martin Luther King Jr. Day, a federal holiday since 1986.
