A single adult host family is defined as one host parent with no full-time children or relatives in the home. An un-related household member in the home (ex: boarder) does not change the status of a single adult host. One relative reference is required for single adult host applicants.

This form should be completed by the YFU volunteer or employee who completed this reference check. The signed form should be submitted to the District Office.
